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## STREET RECONSTRUCTION UPDATE

### Beacon Hill Dr. / Oak Hill Ct. / Wolfzorn Ct.

Dear Fort Wright Resident,

**Weather permitting;** Beginning on or about July 1<sup>st</sup>. The City will begin the 2016 Street Reconstruction Project. The city will spend \$553,027.00 reconstructing Beacon Hill Ct. Oak Hill Ct. and Wolfzorn Ct. We will be removing and replacing the street, some sidewalk and driveway aprons will be replaced as well as part of this project. The street will be removed and replaced in 400 to 500 foot sections. You will be unable to use your driveway for up to as many as ten days to allow for concrete curing. This could happen twice during this project once for the street and once for your driveway apron. The contractor will make every effort to get the access to your driveway restored as quickly as possible. The contractor will provide 24 hours notice prior to blocking you from using your driveway. This will be inconvenient and your patience and cooperation is appreciated. I am strongly recommending if possible to please park on Mt. Vernon whenever possible. There is only one way in or out and trucks will need to back in. It could be as long as a **20 minute** wait to get out. JPS Construction is the contractor for the job. They can be reached during business hours at 859-441-6872. If you have special needs or you will require assistance with getting in and out during this process or need to coordinate any other issue like a delivery or a onetime event, please contact the contractor or (me) Tim Maloney at the city offices. If you have an invisible fence or a lawn irrigation system please mark their locations near the sidewalk or street. We will make every effort to accommodate these items, however the contractor is not responsible for damage of items that are in right-of-way.
