

ORDINANCE _____ - 2017

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF FORT WRIGHT, KENTUCKY, ENACTING A NEW SECTION 91.35 OF THE FORT WRIGHT CODE OF ORDINANCES RELATING TO PEDESTRIANS' DUTIES IN TRAFFIC

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Fort Wright has determined that when pedestrians approach occupants of vehicles being operated upon the streets and highways of the City of Fort Wright, it poses a significant hazard both to pedestrians and motorists;

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Fort Wright desires to impose certain duties on pedestrians when it comes to how they relate to traffic;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF FORT WRIGHT, KENTUCKY:

SECTION 1

Section 91.35 of the Fort Wright Code of Ordinances shall be implemented and enacted to read as follows:

§ 91.35 PEDESTRIANS' DUTIES IN TRAFFIC.

It shall be unlawful for any pedestrian to block any road or street in the City, or to do any act designated to stop, slow or impede the movement of traffic, or to approach stopped motorists in a line of traffic.

SECTION 2

Any and all ordinances in conflict with this ordinance shall be, and hereby are, repealed to the extent of said conflict.

SECTION 3

If any part of this ordinance or its application is deemed invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the City Council intends that such invalidity will not affect the effectiveness of the remaining provisions or applications and, to this end, the provisions of this ordinance are severable.

SECTION 4

That this ordinance shall become effective upon its passage and shall be published under KRS §83A.060(9) and other applicable law.
